



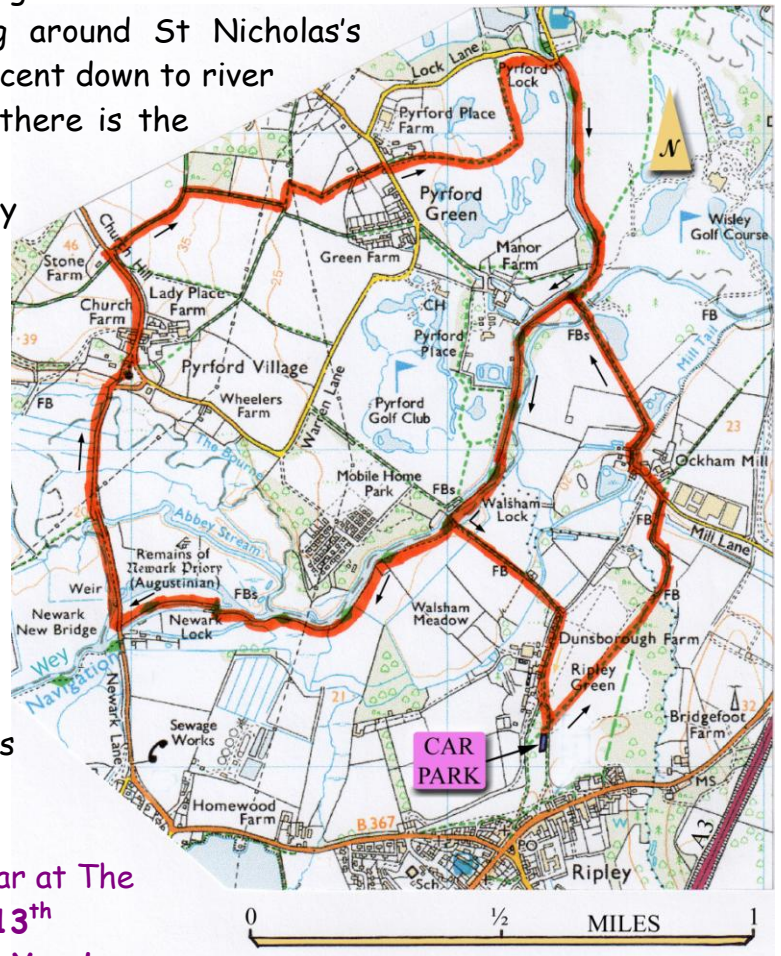

Sunday 9th January 2011

The first walk of the New Year is 6½ miles over the flatlands around Ripley which we last covered 10 years ago. We will be passing beside the River Wey Navigation, crossing a golf course and passing through some woodland. There is a small, but sharp, amount of climbing around St Nicholas's church at Pyrford but then an easy descent down to river level. As with any walk in the winter there is the possibility of mud - please be prepared.

The start is at 10:00 a.m. from Ripley Green public car park (OS Explorer map 145 - grid ref. TQ 053 569). This can be reached by either driving through Pyrford Village on the B367/Pyrford Common Road or via Old Woking and Send on the A247. Once in Ripley, and heading towards London, turn left about 100 yards after the controlled pedestrian crossing onto the village green and head along the narrow roadway to a car park on the left beside a children's play area.
