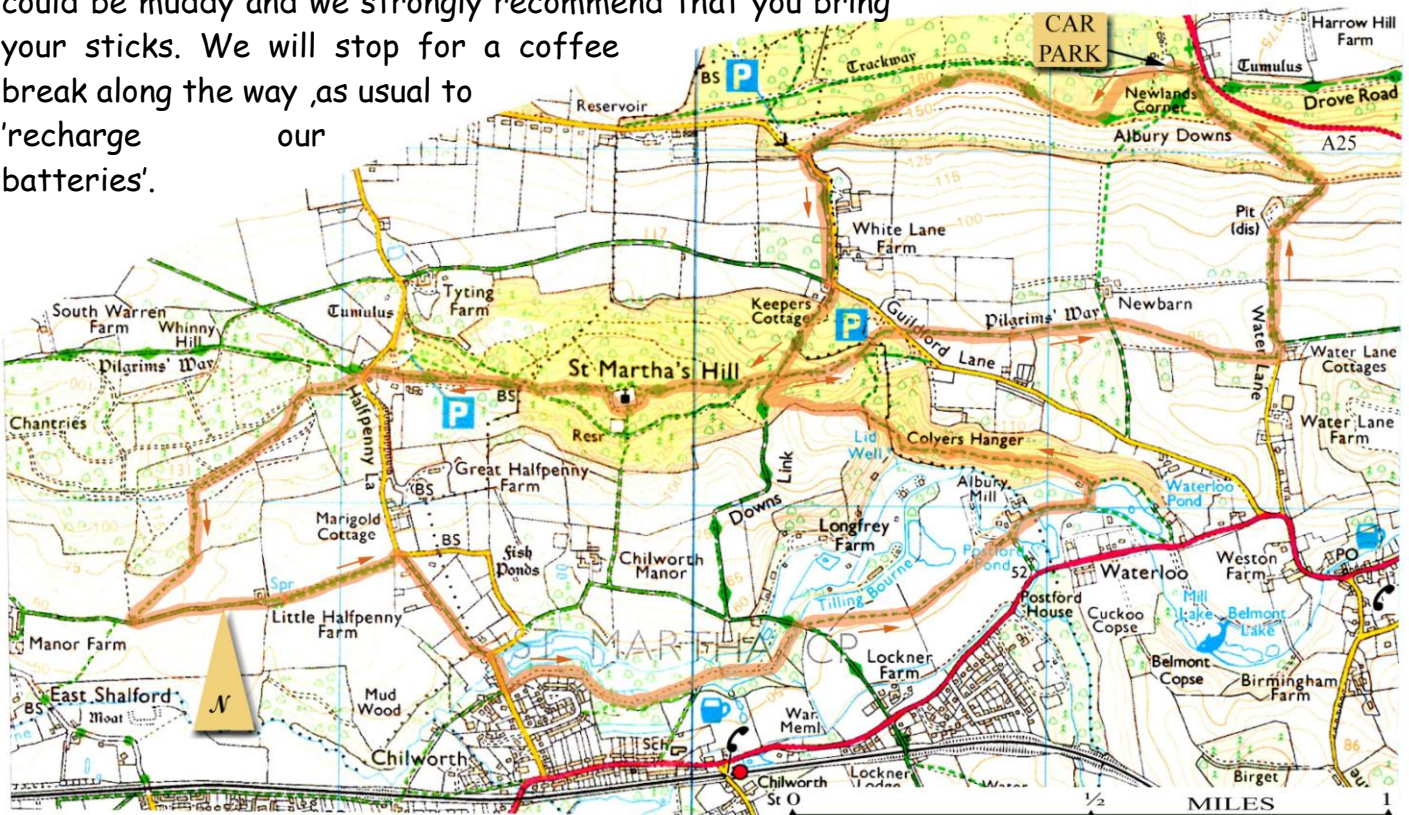
The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society
