



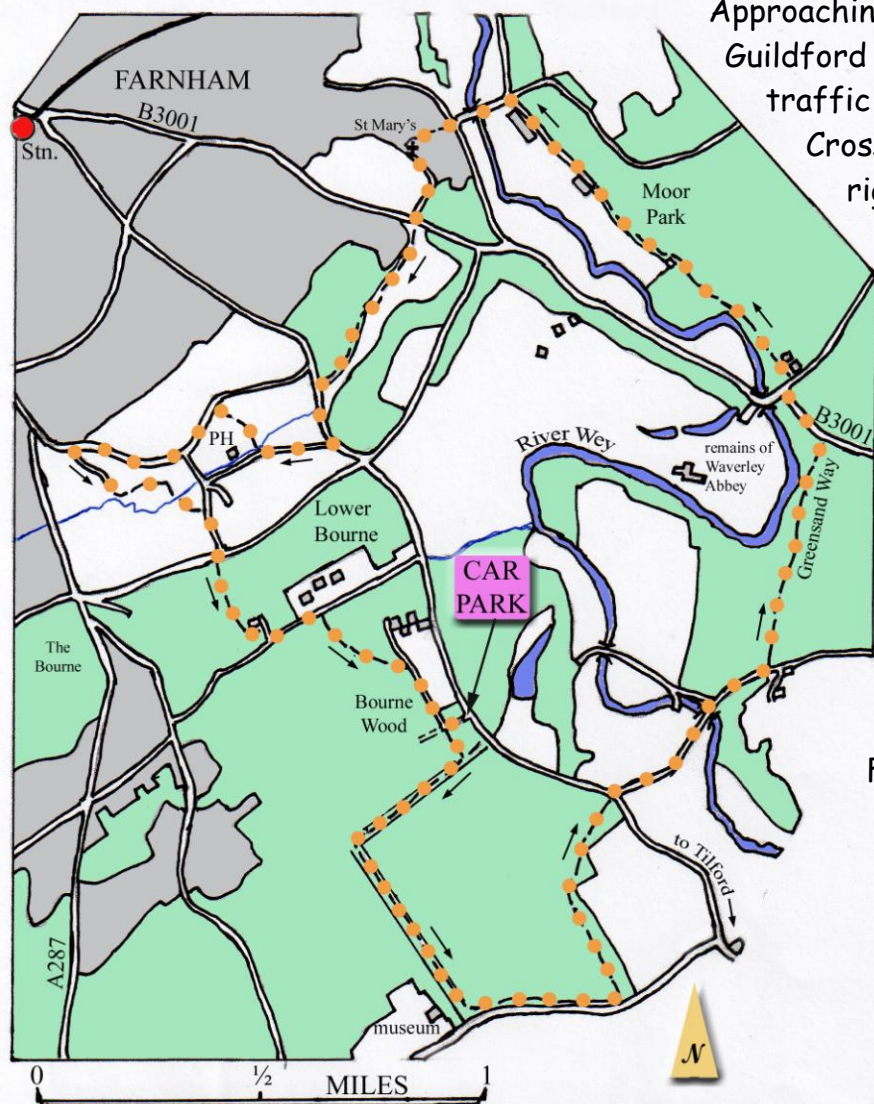

The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society

Sunday 14th March 2010

This is a new walk for us and is situated in the lovely area to the south east of Farnham. Starting in woodland we will pass through a variety of landscapes, including urban ones towards the end of the walk. There is quite a bit of history to take in, some of which is displayed on boards along the way.

Meet at 10 a.m. for this walk of $6\frac{3}{4}$ miles. There are some quite steep climbs and descents to tackle (sticks could be helpful) but no stiles.



Approaching Farnham on the A31 from the Guildford direction, turn left at the traffic lights towards Farnham Station. Cross the level crossing and take the right-hand fork towards Tilford.

Leaving the boundary of Farnham at Red Hill, continue southwards to cross a bridge with red brick parapets over a stream, then pass Lobswood Manor on the right. After a further 200 yards the small Bourne Wood (Forestry Commission) car park (OS Explorer map 145 - grid ref. SU 859 444) is to be found on the right $1\frac{3}{4}$ miles from Farnham Station.

West End to Bourne Wood car park - about 40 mins. **Walk No. 284**
