



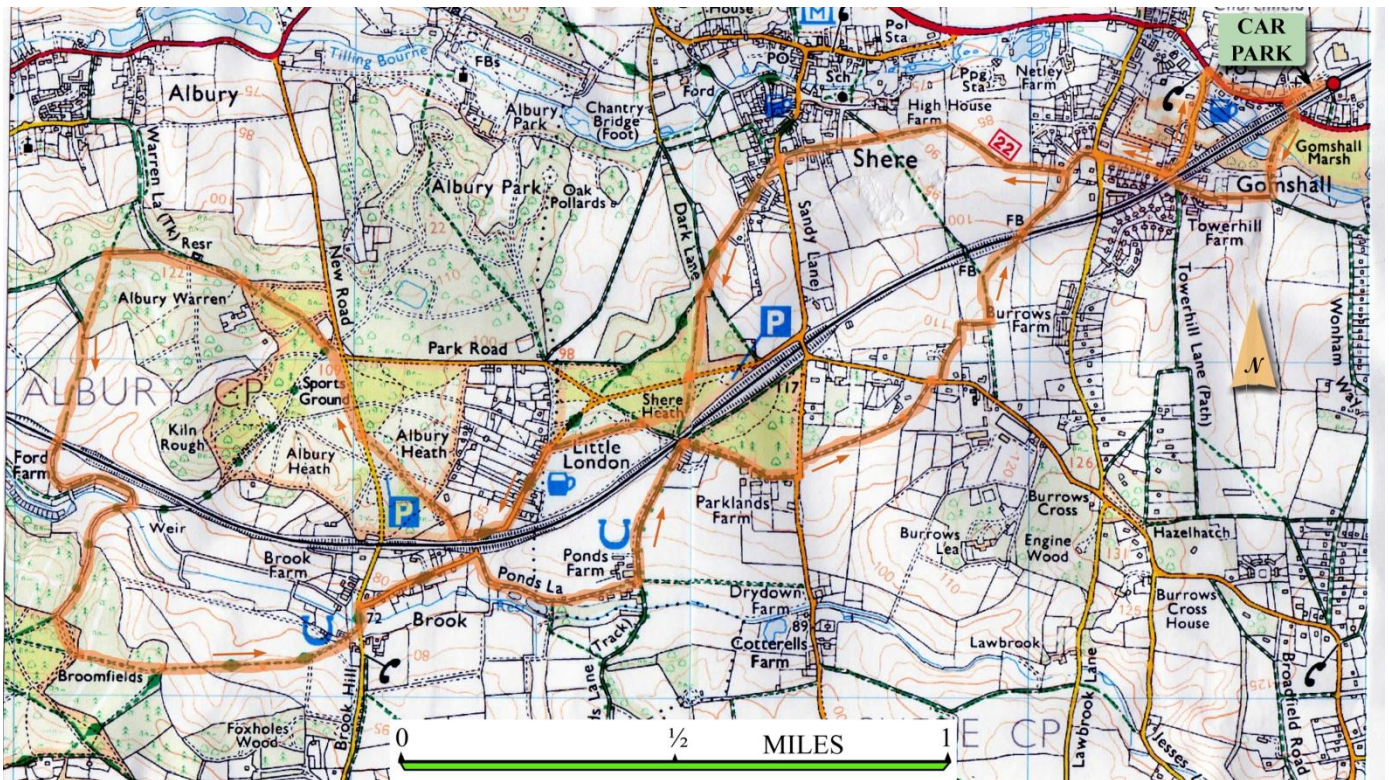

The walk is $7\frac{1}{4}$ miles long and, with only 4 stiles to climb and the going is easy. This delightful saunter is a nice mixture of villages and countryside. Starting at the usual time of 10 a.m. at Gomshall Station car park you should be back at the car park before 2 p.m. There will be the usual break for coffee etc. on the way.

To reach the station car park follow the A25, via Newlands Corner, for 3 miles going east. The station car park is at the far end of Gomshall village, on the left hand side, just before the railway bridge. The parking area is at the top end of the access road and parking is free.
