

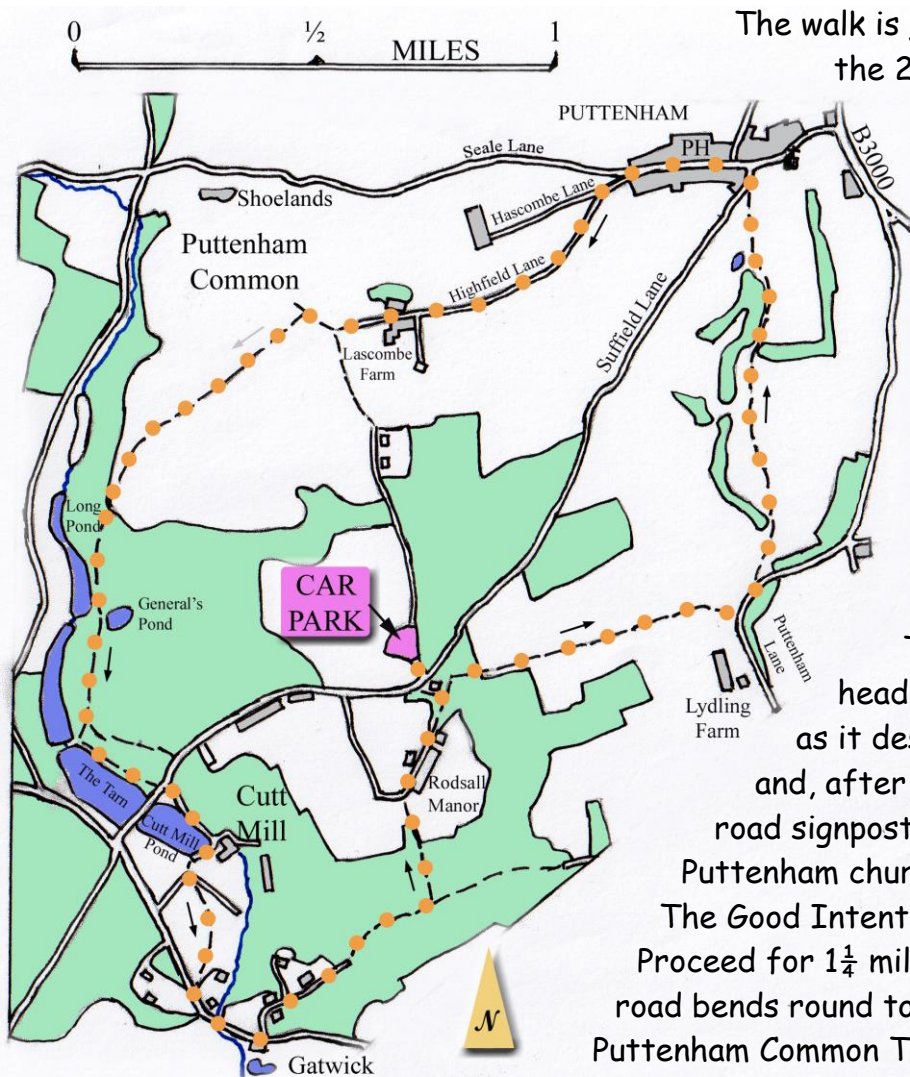


TWERPS

The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society

Sunday 11th April 2010

You might recognise this walk as the one that was 'snowed off' in January; lets hope the weather is a little kinder to us this month. It starts from The Puttenham Common top car park in Suffield Lane (OS Explorer map 145 - grid ref. SU 920 461). We will leave at the usual time of 10.00 a.m. and stop for a break along the way. There is a good pub at Puttenham but it won't be open when we pass it on our expedition so bring a little sustenance to keep you going.



The walk is just over 6 miles long and, in the 2010 programme, I described

it as being 'mainly flat with about a dozen stiles'. We have pre-walked the route and the good news is that there are only 5 stiles that have to be climbed (the others can be circumnavigated) but the going would be best described as 'undulating' with several fairly steep, but short, sections.

To reach the starting point, head towards the A3 on the B3000 as it descends from the Hog's Back and, after a $\frac{1}{4}$ mile, turn right onto the road signposted to Puttenham. Just after Puttenham church and before the pub called The Good Intent, turn left into Suffield Lane. Proceed for $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles and at the point where the road bends round to the right there is a sign for Puttenham Common Top Car Park: turn right into the car park.

West End to Puttenham Common Top Car Park - about 40 mins. **Walk No. 285**

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
