The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society

Sunday 13th June 2010

Ann Armstrong and Keith Atkins have proposed repeating the walk first covered in August 2008 and have kindly checked it out. It is a fairly level walk with a small incline, 8 or 9 styles and a tiny amount of mud which could get worse if we have a lot of rain. The route goes towards Hascombe Hill but turns back before climbing the main part of the hill. The final part of the walk is along Downs Link. Total distance is about 7 miles and Ann has found a nice shaded spot for elevenses. It is hoped to be back at the car park between 2.00 and 2.30 p.m.

To reach the starting point (10 a.m. start), and coming from the Guildford direction, follow the A281 towards Horsham and go through Shalford and Bramley. Approximately 5 miles from Guildford (just past Birtley Green) turn left onto the B2128: this is signposted to Cranleigh. Follow further signs to Cranleigh then, at the start of the town, follow the signs to Horsham.

Several nearby venues have been recommended for those that want an after-walk lunch. If interested contact Keith on 01 483 267 040 for further details.

On entering Cranleigh ignore the sign to the first car park near Sainsbury's. Carry on to the next mini-roundabout by the village hall and take the right-hand exit. The estate agents, Burns & Webber, are on the corner and the Village Hall faces you as you turn right. The Leisure Centre car park (OS Explorer map 134 - grid ref. TQ 059 389) is on the left and is free on Sundays.
