Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2013

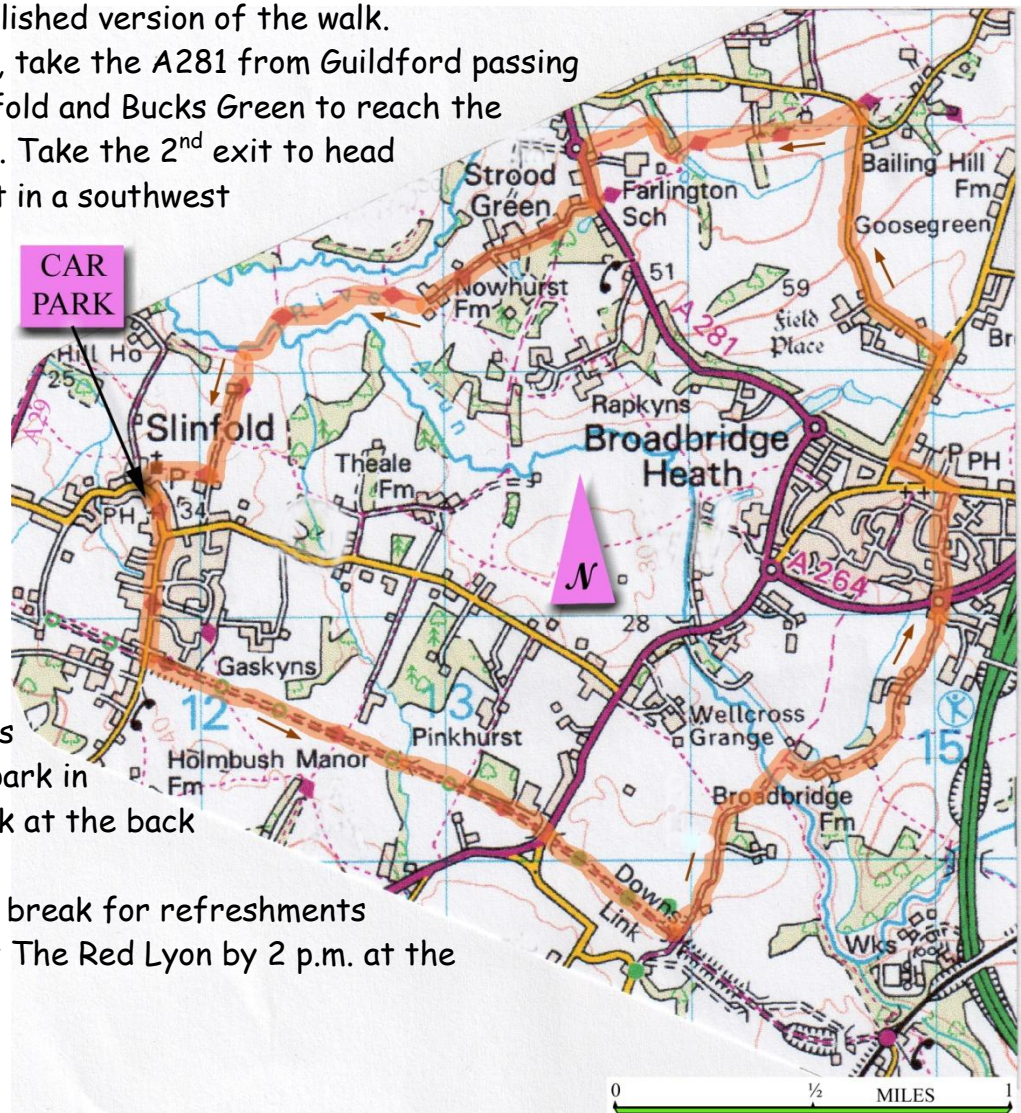
Those that attended the mid-summer walk round Chobham may be interested to know that, after we got back to the car park, Ian Cameron and Ron Nolan were discovered patiently waiting for us at The Sun pub. in Chobham: we joined them to talk of old times.

This month's walk of  $7\frac{1}{4}$  miles is very gentle and *there are no stiles*. However, it can be muddy in places after wet weather. We are starting at 10 a.m. from The Red Lyon pub in Slinfold: we felt that this was a more amenable place to meet than a Tesco car park as suggested in the published version of the walk.

To reach the start, take the A281 from Guildford passing through Bramley, Alfold and Bucks Green to reach the A29 at a roundabout. Take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit to head towards Billingshurst in a southwest

direction on the A29. After just over  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles take the turning on the left signposted Slinfold and wind your way through the village to the pub on the right having just passed the church on the left. The landlord has agreed that we can park in the overflow car park at the back of the pub.

Including the usual break for refreshments we should be back at The Red Lyon by 2 p.m. at the latest.
