Sunday 12th July 2015

This walk begins just south of Leatherhead and was last done 16 years ago although we have had several walks in the area since then, We have modified the original route a

little and come up with an interesting 7½ mile walk which skirts Box Hill and has only a few ups and downs - none of them are particularly challenging.

There are no stiles and with a break for your snack on a hillside with a lovely view we should be back at the car park by 2 p.m.. Starting time is the usual 10 a.m.

To reach the Norbury Park Young Street car park join the A246 from Guildford and head for Leatherhead passing through East Clandon and Effingham. The car park is about ¾ of a mile from the roundabout on the outskirts of Great Bookham. From the roundabout the road dips downhill to go under a railway bridge and the car park entrance is immediately past the bridge on the right-hand side. If the traffic is too heavy to make this right-hand turn safely we suggest that you carry on past the car park entrance for a ¼ of a mile to the next roundabout and then return to enter the car park on the left.
