We start this walk of nearly 8 miles from the car park at the Tarns at Puttenham, the walk is through parts of the Alice Holt Forest, around Crooksbury Hill and the beautiful farm land near Tilford and Charles Hill. At Charles Hill there is the lovely, popular Donkey Pub, which we pass on our route. The terrain is pretty gentle with one or two tiny undulations! There are no stiles and there was no mud on the pre-walk but I could be speaking too soon. We will meet at 10 a.m. at the Tarns and plan to stop for coffee by the Wey at Tilford. We should be back to the carpark by 2:30 p.m.

To get to The Tarn Car Park, turn right (west) off the B3000 at Puttenham into the village and take the first turn on the left, (about 250 yards down the hill past the church) into Suffield Lane. Drive on for about 2 miles to The Tarn, at the cross roads turn right, car park on right.
