The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society

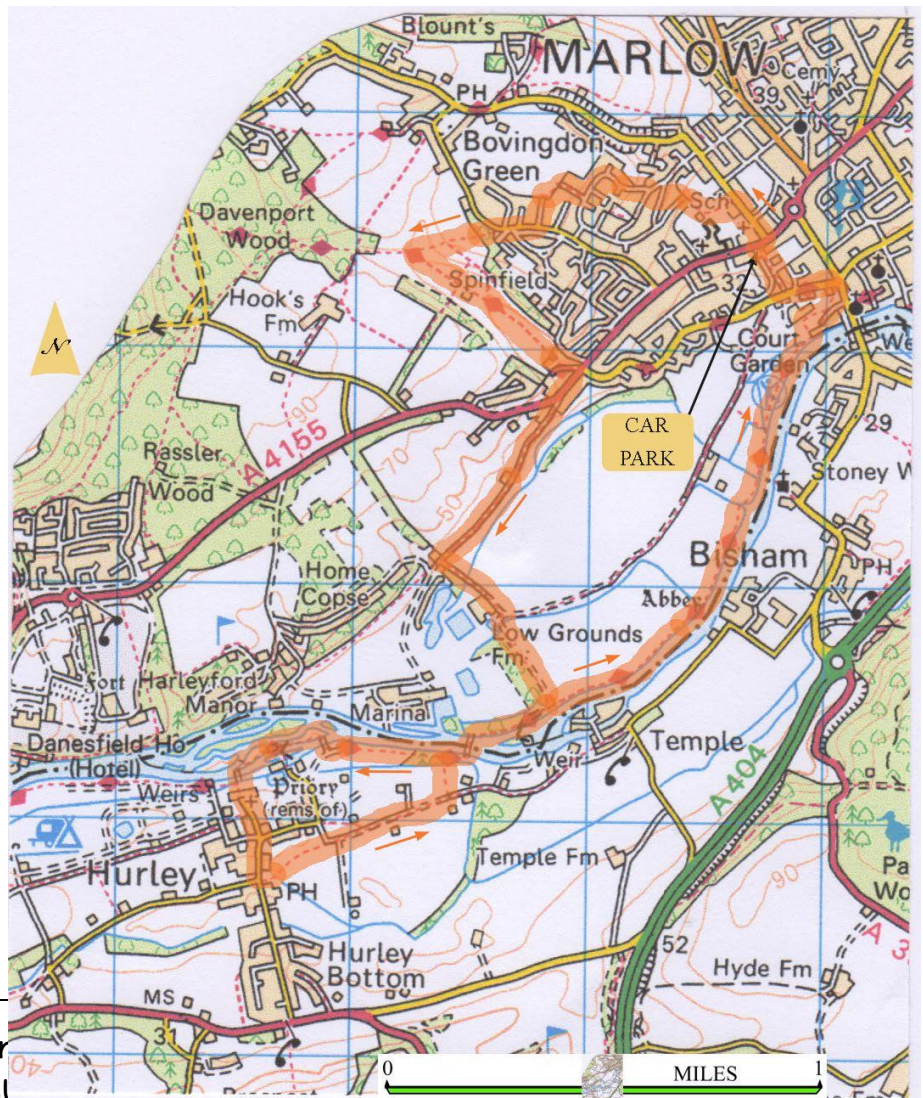
Sunday 9th July 2017

This month's walk starts from Marlow and is part 2 of the walks featuring the Thames Path. The walk starts with a gentle climb through the north of Marlow to reach a ridge from which we make a gradual descent down the peaceful Happy Valley walking through farm land to reach the banks of the Thames. We will stop for 'elevenses' at Hurley Lock where sustenance in the form of coffee, tea, cake and ice cream can be purchased from the teashop. From here we continue to Hurley and Bisham which have many fabulous old buildings including a Norman Church. We return to walk back along the Thames Path back to Marlow.

The length of the walk is 7 miles with a short cut to reduce it to 4.5 miles. The walk is very pleasant and easy going with no stiles.

To reach the start access the A404 (M) heading for the M40 and High Wycombe. Turn left at the roundabout to Bisham and Temple. This road meanders through both villages to reach the bridge over the river Thames in Marlow itself. Cross the bridge go straight over the double roundabout turn left onto the A4155. The West Street car park is approximately 200 metres on the left just past the Oxford Road on your right. Grid Ref: SU 847 863 - OS Explorer 172.

Charges for Sunday are £1 daily charge. You will need to know your registration number which has to be keyed into the payment machine and then follow the
