At Polstead Manor there is an easy climb to reach the North Downs Way and then we follow it back to the Wey valley. Somewhere along the way we will be stopping for a break - bring your own refreshments.

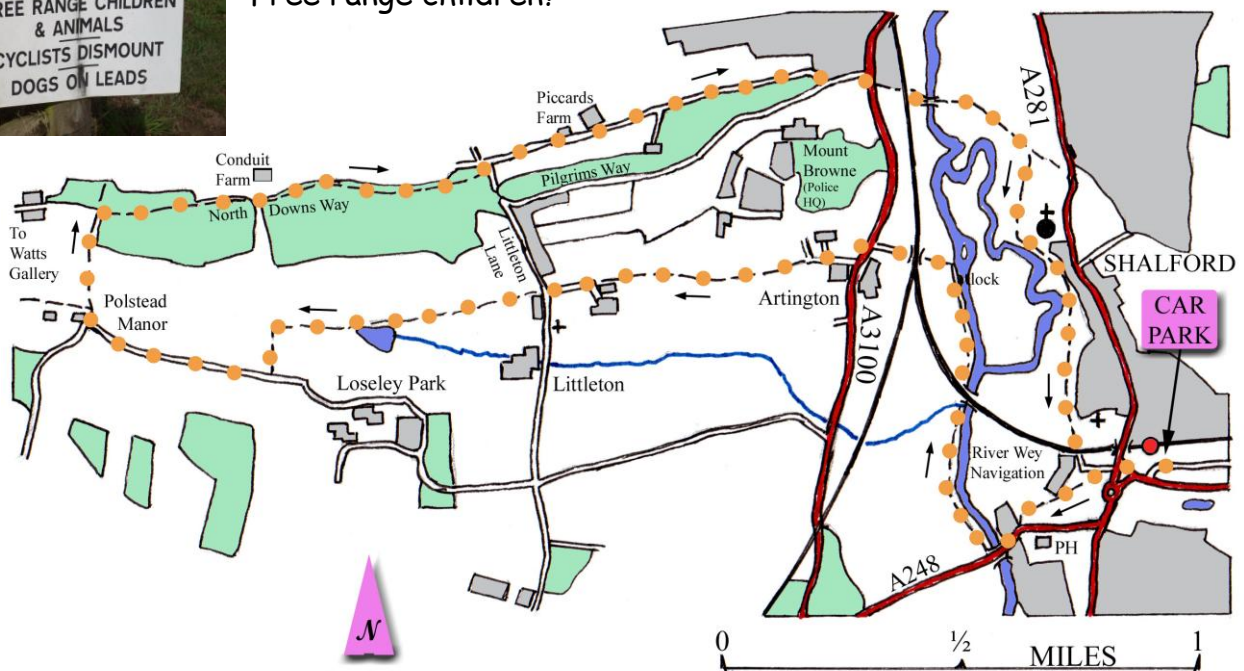
The stretch of track past Mount Browne is rather over grown with grass and some stinging nettles so please come fully prepared.

Starting time is the usual 10 a.m. from Shalford station car park (OS Explorer map 145 - grid ref. TQ 002 470). There does not seem to be any restriction on parking and the trains are few and far between on a Sunday morning. Shalford is reached by heading south from Guildford on the A 281 for just under 2 miles. After passing over the railway lines at Shalford, take the first turning immediately on the left and then the first turning on the left again to enter the station car park.

There are several places where the walk could be shortened if required. Please let us know if you would like to do this and we will advise the best route to take. Return time at the car park should be about 1 p.m.
