The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society

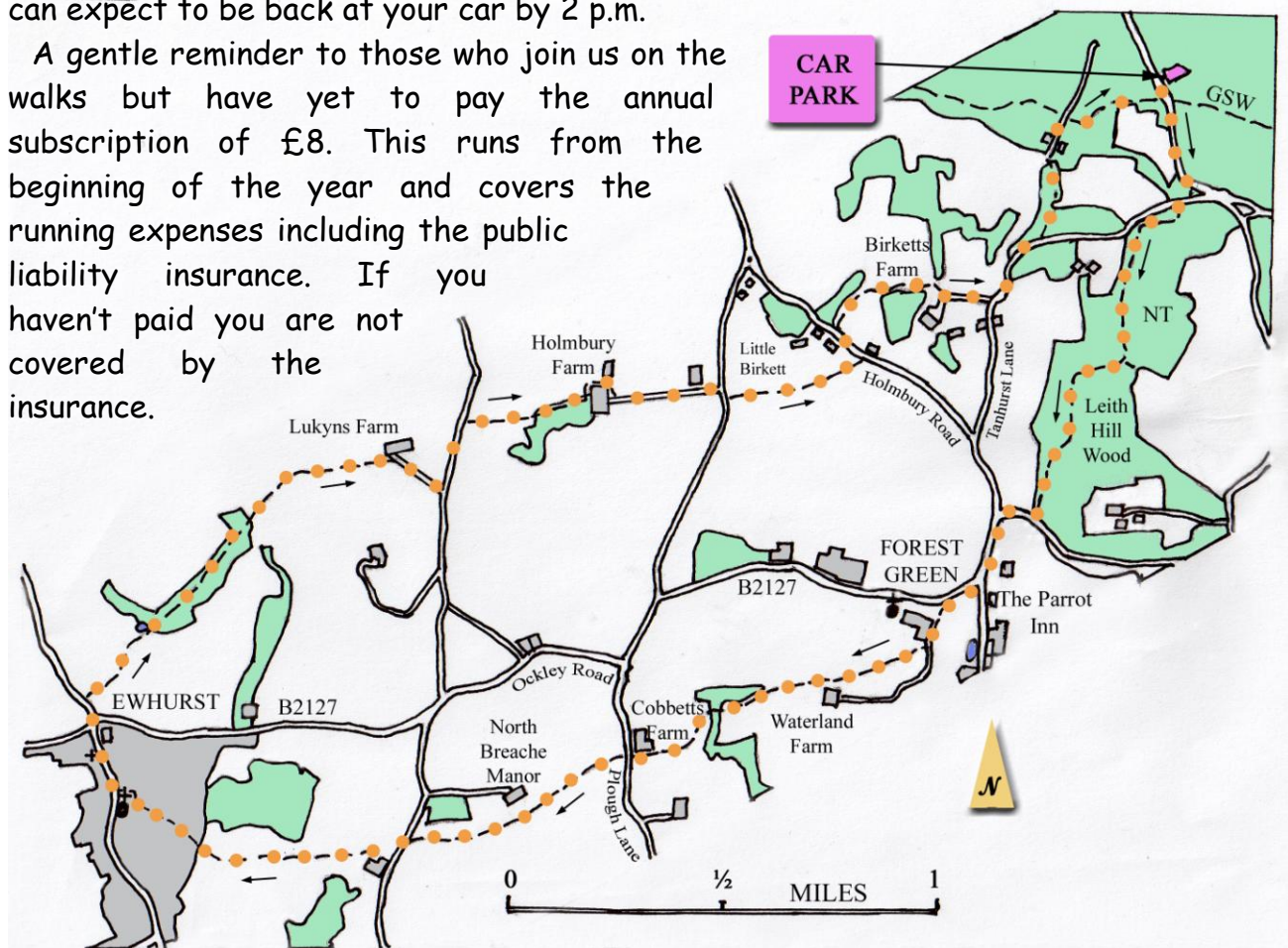
Sunday 8th August 2010

We have moved away from the flat walks of the last few months to an old one, last walked in April 2002, of 7½ miles in the lovely rolling countryside of the Surrey hills. There are some steep climbs, particularly towards the end of the walk, and about 20 stiles to negotiate although there may be access round some of them.

The start is at 10 a.m. from the main car park at Leith Hill known as Starveall Corner (OS Explorer map - grid ref. TQ 131 433). Approaching along the A25 from Guildford and Newlands Corner pass through Abinger Hammer and, after 1½ miles, turn right down Hollow Lane (signposted to Abinger Common, Friday Street and Leith Hill). After a little under 3 miles, and about 400 yards past a sign on the right to High Ashes Farm, the car park is reached on the left.

There will be the usual stop for our refreshments just over half way round and you can expect to be back at your car by 2 p.m.

A gentle reminder to those who join us on the walks but have yet to pay the annual subscription of £8. This runs from the beginning of the year and covers the running expenses including the public liability insurance. If you haven't paid you are not covered by the insurance.
