*The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society*

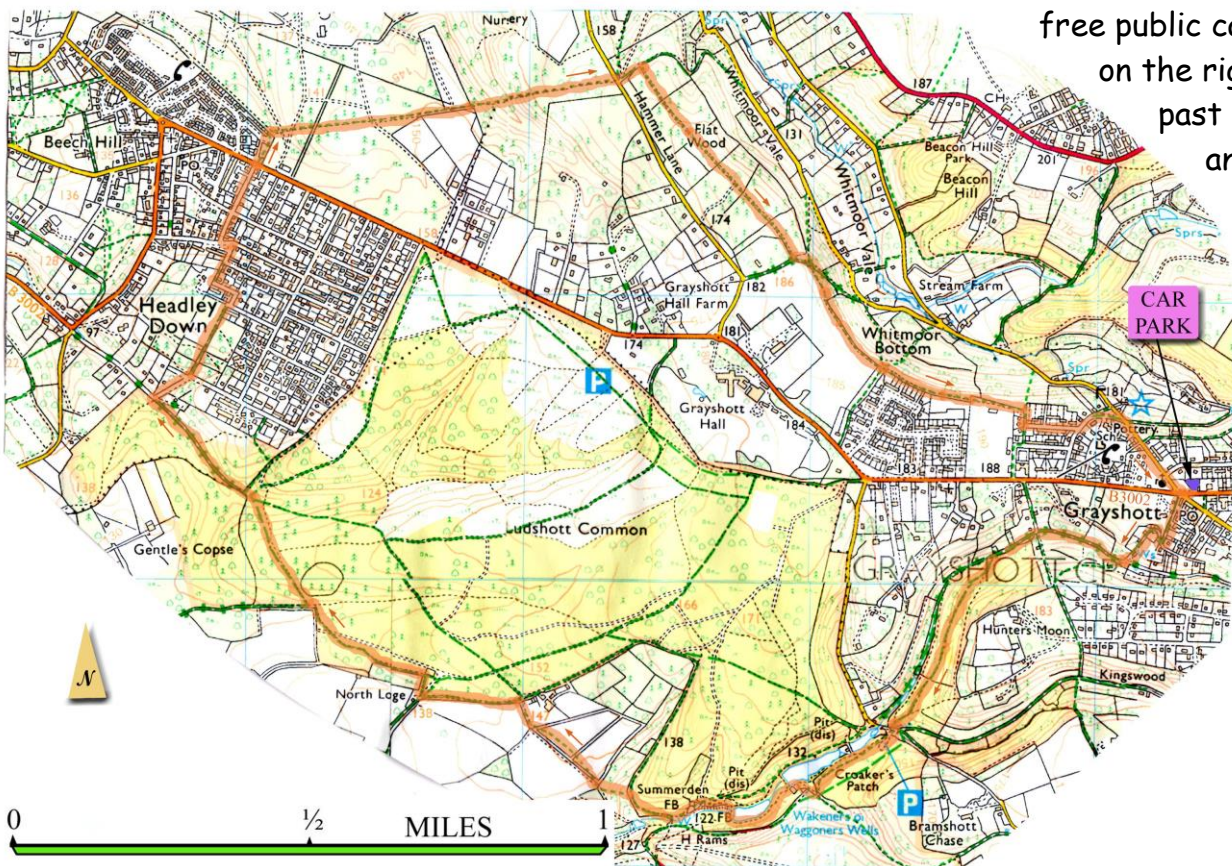
**Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2015**

A similar walk to last month's in that it is about 6½ miles long and involves a few short but steep climbs. There are only 3 stiles to negotiate. The 10 a.m. start is in a public car park in Grayshott.

The walk goes past the lovely Waggoners Wells ponds and through some beautiful woodland and fields in and around Headley Down and Grayshott. The Grayshott Pottery has a very good café and it is at the end of our walk so you might like to stop there for second lunch. We will be stopping for a break about halfway round to have your refreshments.

To reach the car park take the A3 to the south-west away from Guildford and pass through the new tunnel around the Devil's Punchbowl. At the first exit go up the hill and exit right at the roundabout to cross over the A3. At the 2<sup>nd</sup> roundabout take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit towards Grayshott and Hindhead: the old A3. At the next roundabout take the first exit to Grayshott (B3002). Continue for ¾ of a mile through the village of Grayshott and the

free public car park is on the right just past the Fox and Pelican pub.
