Sunday 13th August 2017

The walk this month is around Wormley and Chiddingfold and starts from the Witley Station car park.

This picturesque walk shows the Surrey countryside at its best. The route alternates through shady woodland and rolling farmland. We will stop for coffee at Treacle's café on the green at Chiddingfold, or bring your own if you prefer.

The countryside may be fairly dry at the moment but be prepared for inclement weather and muddy paths on the day. The walk is about 8 miles long.

To get to the start, travel down the A3 coming off at the Milford exit onto the A283. Pass through the traffic lights at Milford and head towards Witley and Wormley on the A283. At the roundabout turn right and go to Witley. Having passed the large King Edward School on the right, cross a railway bridge and turn right down Combe Lane for $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile, passing the Wood Pidgeon Pub, and take the first turning into the station car park.

West End to Witley Station - about 45 mins. **Walk No. 64** Starting point - O.S. grid ref. SU 948 379, O.S. Explorer 133. ~ Lat. 51° 07' 57.14" N, Long. 0° 38' 47.46" W
