



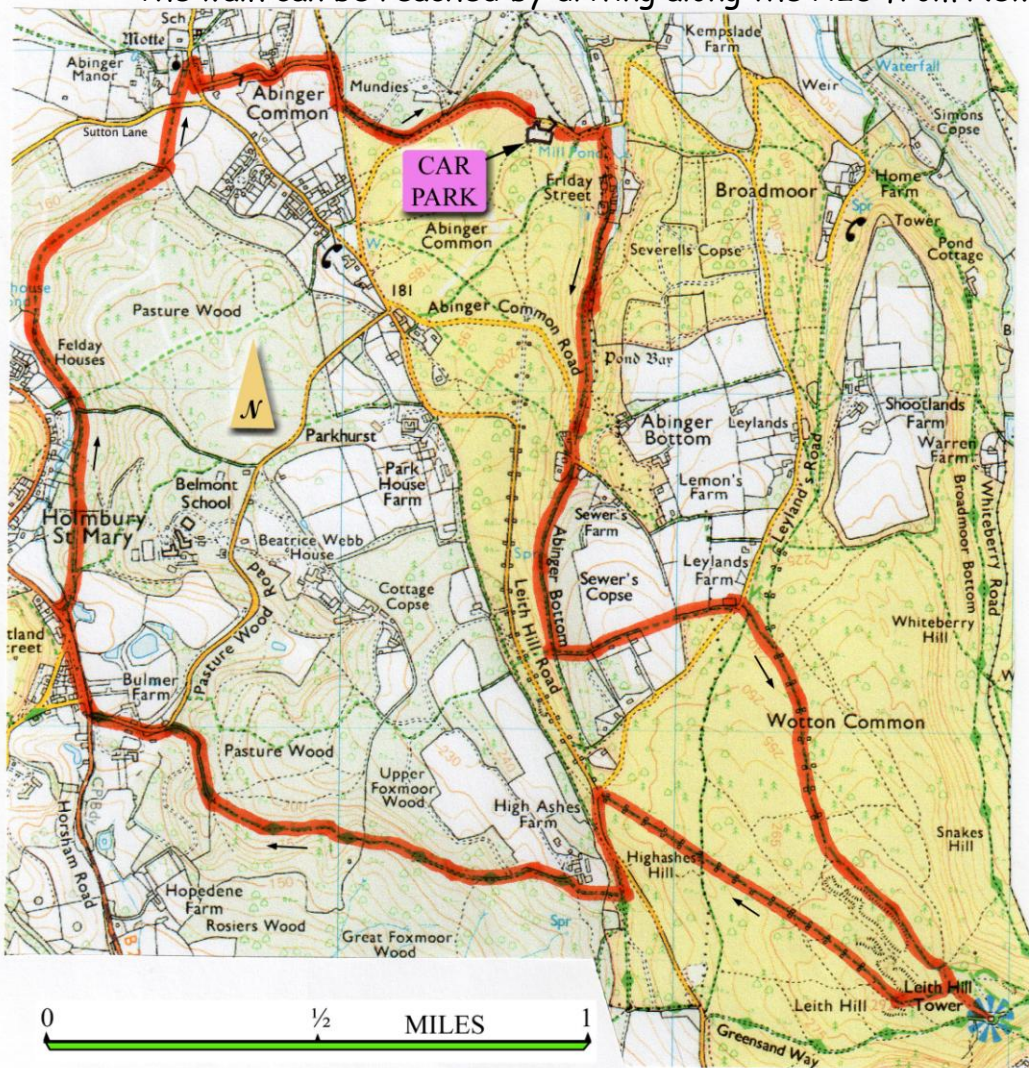
# TWERPS

The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society

Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> September 2011

This walk is in the leafy Surrey Hills, on and near Leith Hill and some of the Abingers. It is 6½ miles long and it does go up and down a bit but has only 2 stiles. Keith Atkins and Ann Armstrong will be leading the walk and they suggest stopping for a break at Leith Hill Tower, where tea and coffee can be purchased from the National Trust shop. Later we will be passing the Abinger Hatch Pub; it has been recently refurbished and does good food. If you want lunch there I suggest you book up - phone no. 01306 0730737. The car park is only about half an hour from the pub. We should be back at the car park before 2.00p.m. (depending how long you spend at the pub).

The walk can be reached by driving along the A25 from Newlands Corner to pass



through Gomshall and Abinger Hammer. After a further 1½ miles turn right into Hollow Lane (signposted to Abinger Hammer, Friday Street and Leith Hill). About a mile later, after passing some houses on the right, take a narrow acute left turn (signposted Friday Street) to arrive at the car park (OS Explorer map 146 - grid ref. TQ 125 458) on the right after half a mile.
