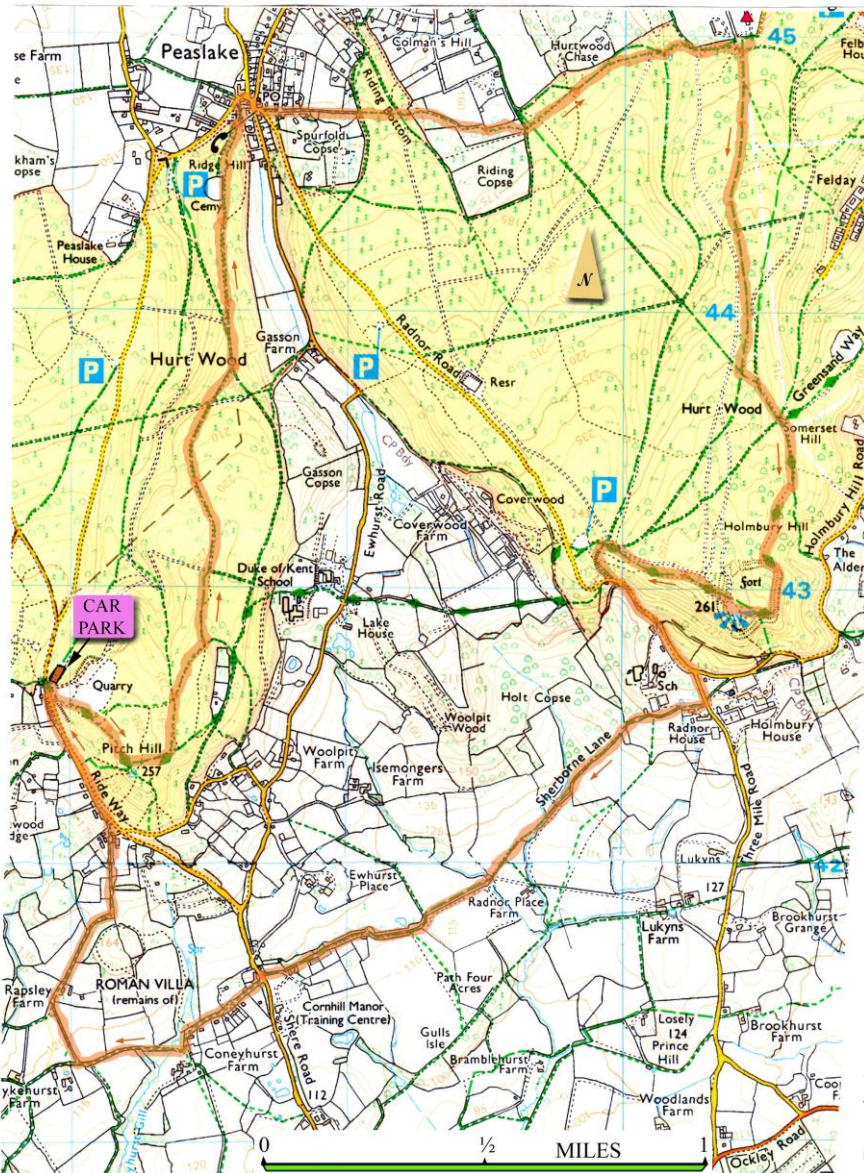
The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society

Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2015

This scenic walk is about 8 miles long and includes Pitch Hill as well as Holmbury Hill. Both elevations are over 800 ft. high but as we don't start at sea level the

inclines are mostly fairly gradual. However, the going is a bit rough and stony in parts and could be a bit slippery in the wet; hence a stick would be very useful. We start at 10 a.m. from Hurtwood Control Car Park which is below Pitch Hill and mid-way between Peaslake and Ewhurst.

The best approach is through the village of Shere (just off the A25) heading in a southerly direction. After crossing the railway bridge, which is about  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile outside Shere, take the right fork, signposted EWHURST. The car park is about 3 miles down a very narrow road (beware of fast-approaching vehicles). After passing Bentley Copse Scout Camp on the left, and just after a road junction on the left, the car park entrance is on the left as the road starts to descend. If you get



to the Windmill pub. on the right you have gone too far. We intend to stop for a late 'elevenses' on Holmbury Hill and our return to the car park will be at about 2:30 p.m..

West End to Pitch Hill free car park - about 45 mins. **Walk No. 355**
