

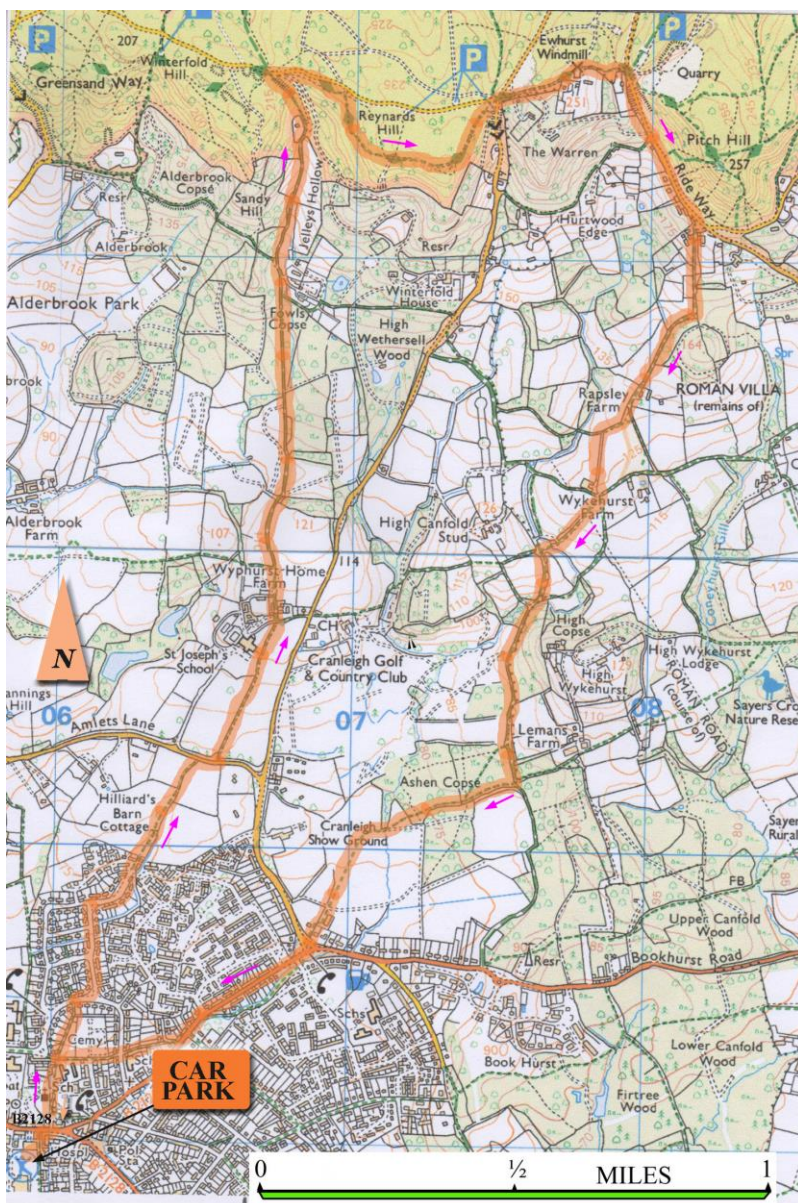


TWERPS

The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society

Sunday 11th September 2016

This is a $6\frac{3}{4}$ mile walk (without stiles) we covered back in 2007 and we feel it is time to check it out again. The first part is through the northern part of Cranleigh then a steady, but quite gentle, climb to meet up with the Greensand Way on Winterfold Hill; where we aim to have our 'elevensies' and admire the views. The last 'leg' to the top is fairly



steep and rough so we advise using sticks if you feel it would help. From there we descend gently back to Cranleigh arriving no later than 2 p.m.

To reach the starting point (at 10 a.m.), and coming from the Guildford direction, follow the A281 towards Horsham and go through Shalford and Bramley. Approximately 5 miles from Guildford (just past Birtley Green) turn left onto the B2128. Follow further signs to Cranleigh then, at the start of the town, follow the signs to Horsham.

Ignoring the sign to the first car park near Sainsbury's, continue on to the next mini-roundabout by the village hall and take the right-hand exit. The Leisure Centre car park is on the left. Note that there is a charge for parking.
