Sunday 10th September 2017

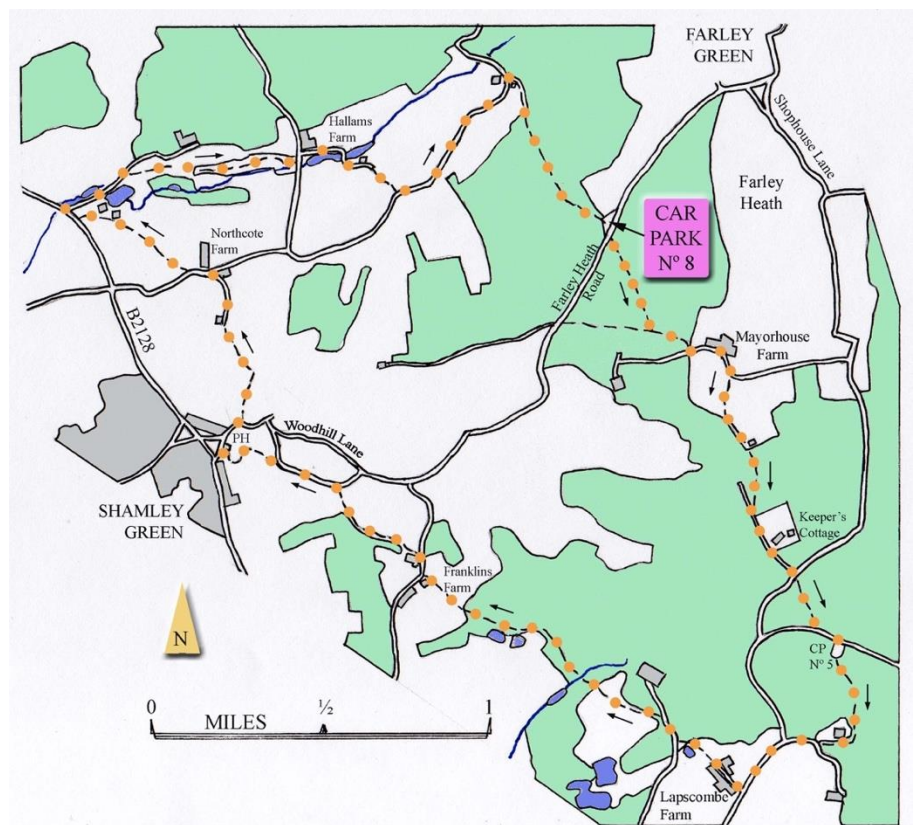
We have to change the walks programme again, due to ill health and holidays; with the September walk reverting to the original location. If anyone feels that they would like to plan and lead a new October walk please contact us.

This month's ramble is a pretty walk of about 7½ miles. We should have completed the circuit by about 2 p.m. The terrain is pleasantly undulating with no serious inclines. If we have had rain prior to the 10th it could be very muddy; so please bring the appropriate gear. There are about 20 stiles.

We will set out from Winterfold Car park number eight (OS Explorer map 145, grid ref. TQ 051 448) on the Farley Green/ Shamley Green Road, at the usual time of 10.00 a.m. and head south through the Winterfold Forest to the edge of the Downs.

We then turn west towards Shamley Green where we will stop for a break along the way. We suggest you bring some refreshments.

Getting to the start from Newlands Corner, via the A25, turn right after 1 mile (opposite Silent Pool) down the A248. After ½ mile, when the road swings round to the right, take the left fork (named New Road) which is signposted to Albury Heath, Farley Green and Peaslake. Keep straight on for just under a mile to reach the rail crossing in Brook. A little further on

in Farley Green take the right-hand fork signposted to Shamley Green (becoming Farley Heath Road) to reach the car park, on the right, after just under $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile.
