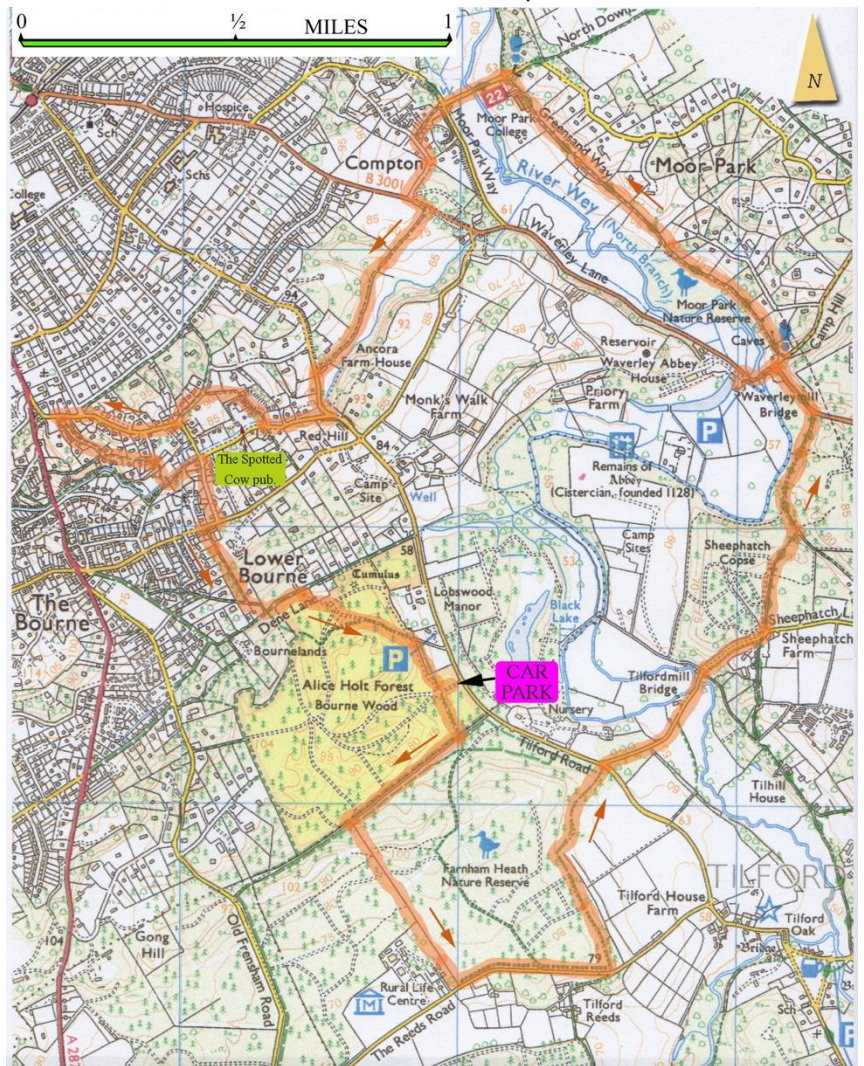
The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society

Sunday 9th October 2016

This walk of 7½ miles is situated in the lovely area to the south east of Farnham. Starting in woodland we will pass through a variety of landscapes, including some interesting urban ones towards the end of the walk. There is quite a bit of history to take in, some of which is displayed on boards along the way. The starting time is the usual 10 a.m. with a break near the site of Waverley Abbey.

There are some quite steep climbs and descents to tackle (sticks could be helpful) but no stiles. Approaching Farnham on the A31 from the Guildford direction, turn left at the traffic lights towards Farnham Station. Cross the level crossing and take the right-hand fork towards Tilford. Leaving the boundary of Farnham at Red Hill, continue southwards to cross a bridge with red brick parapets over a stream, then pass Lobswood Manor on the right. After a further 200 yards the small Bourne Wood (Forestry Commission) car park (OS Explorer map 145) is to be found on the right 1¾ miles from Farnham Station.

While checking out the route we came across **The Spotted Cow pub.** at Lower Bourne and thought it would be rather nice to go there for a meal after the walk. If you wish to join us there, please telephone/email us well before the day so that we can make a booking.
