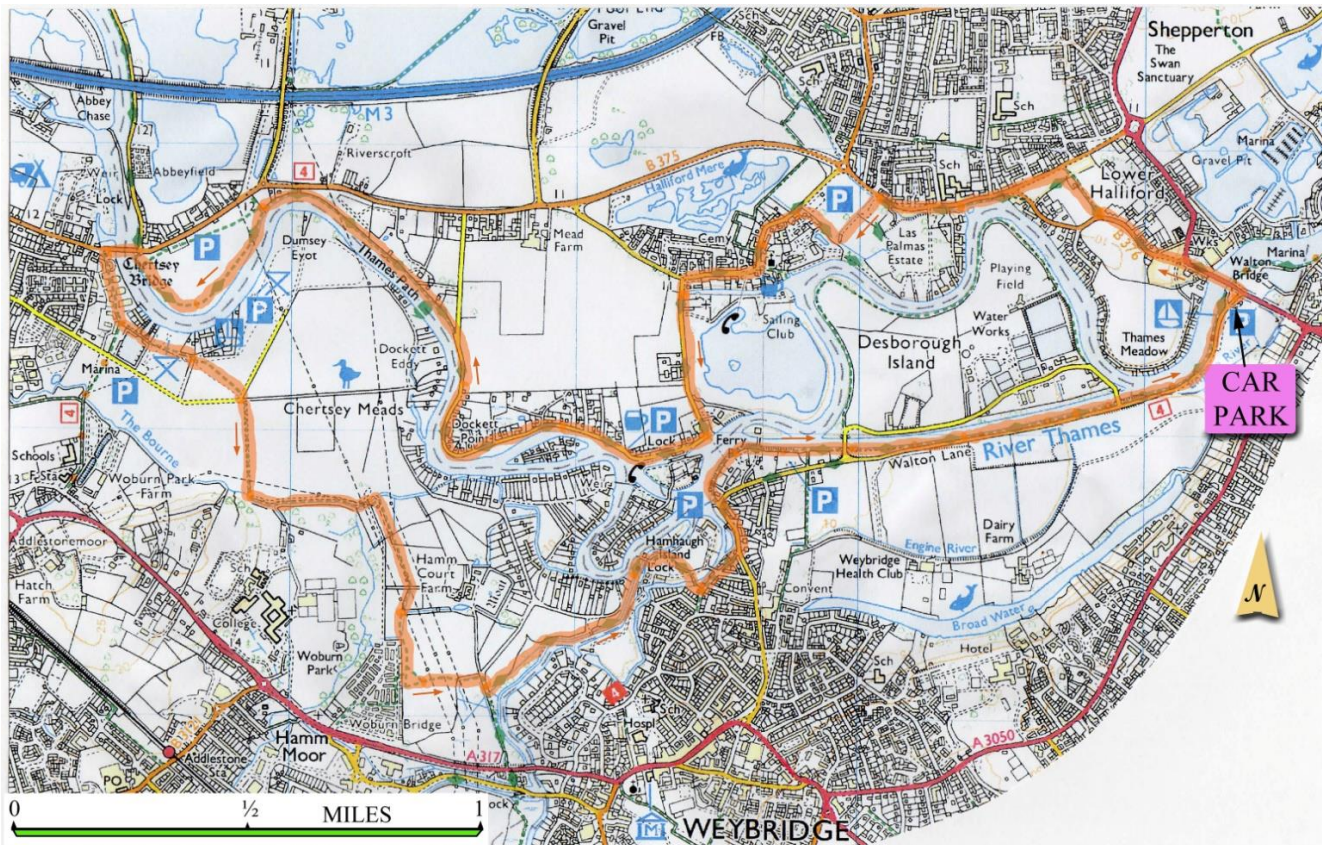
The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society

Sunday 15th November 2015

We have now returned from our U.S. holiday and give our thanks to Terri, Chris and Bailey for leading the September walk in our absence: we hear you all had a great day.

You may recognise the walk from October last year. We liked it so much that we thought we would do it again this year. Beulah and Barry have agreed to lead this walk again.

The walk of 7½ miles is flat, varied and interesting and is on paths along the Thames, on pavements, through meadows and with only two stiles. If there has been rain in the days prior to the walk, the latter stages through Chertsey Meads are likely to be wet and muddy underfoot. As usual we will stop for 'elevensies' about half-way round. We meet at the public, Walton Bridge, car park at 10:00 a.m. and should be back there, at the end of the walk, by 2pm.



Assuming that you approach the car park through Weybridge, drive through the town along the High Street until the road bears round to the right then turn left at an obelisk at Monument Green into Thames Street. This road becomes Walton Lane at the point where there is a sharp bend to the right. Continue along the lane for 1¼ miles, with the River Thames appearing on the left hand side, until Walton Bridge hoves into view. The car park is just before the bridge on the right-hand side.

West End to Walton Bridge car park entrance- about 40 mins. **Walk No. 357**
