



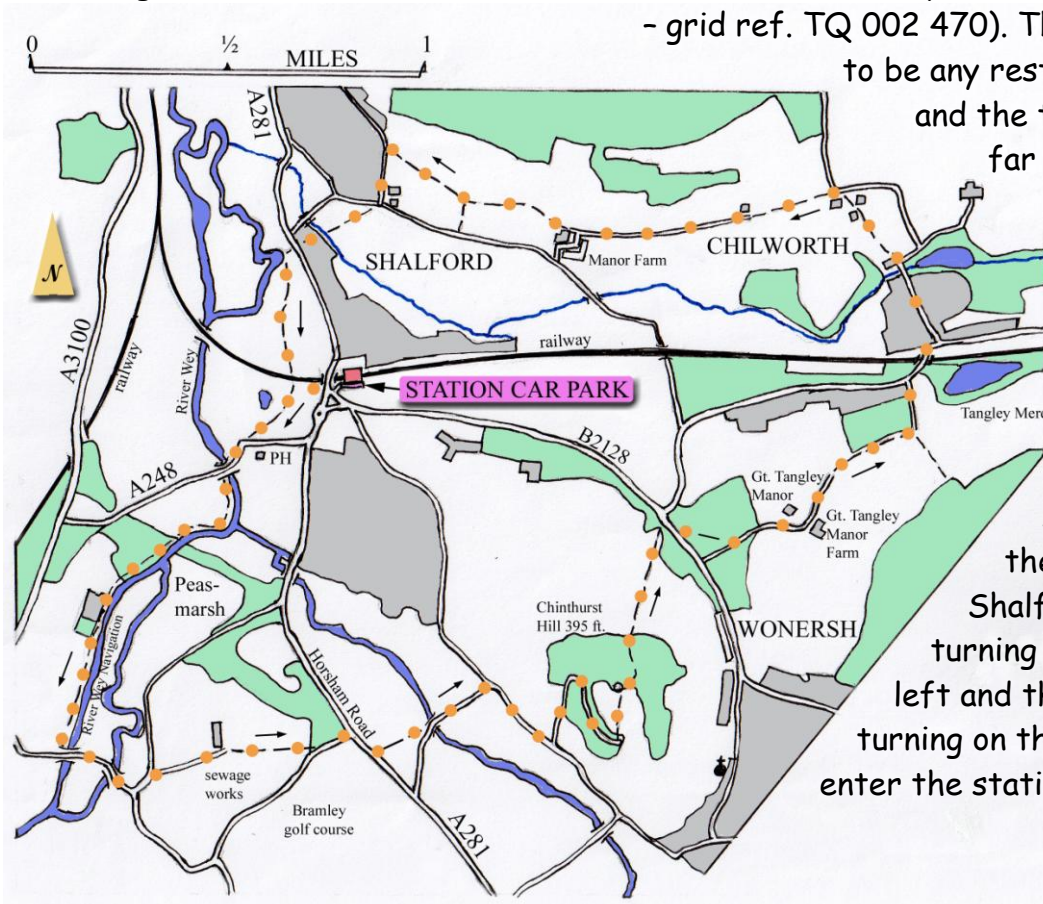

The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society

Sunday 13th December 2009

We hope you all had a good 2009 and want to wish you happy rambling in 2010. We felt we needed to change from the walk shown on the 2009 programme as this has access problems, and we have substituted this one last done in March 2004. We are sure you will enjoy this delightful 7 mile walk which is generally flat with only one short, but steep, climb up Chinthurst Hill to be rewarded by a fine view of the surrounding countryside. This walk starts from Shalford and goes south along side the Wey Navigation for about a mile then swings east wards towards Chinthurst Hill, where we will have a break because we will have earned it. There are several stiles; apart from the hill the rest of the walk is fairly flat. Just remember it is December and you need appropriate clothing and foot wear.

Starting time is the usual 10 a.m. from Shalford station car park (OS Explorer map 145 - grid ref. TQ 002 470). There does not seem



to be any restriction on parking and the trains are few and far between on a Sunday morning. Shalford is reached by heading south from Guildford on the A 281 for just under 2 miles. After passing over the railway lines at Shalford, take the first turning immediately on the left and then the first turning on the left again to enter the station car park.
