

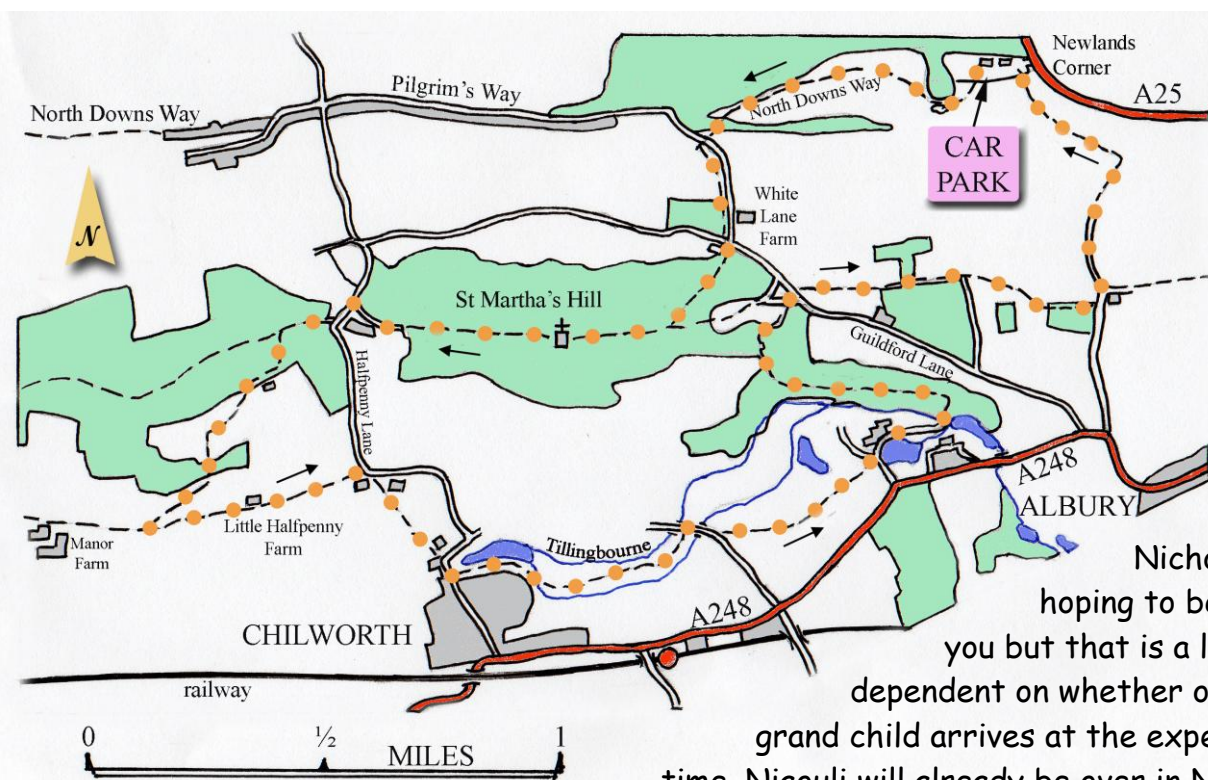


# TWERPS

It is in a very pretty part of the Surrey Hills and the trees should be starting to wear their autumn tints by this time. There are three steep segments, one being at the end as we approach the car park, but other than that it is undulating or downhill! The views are fantastic and we will pass by an interesting historical site where gunpowder mills were once situated on the banks of the Tilling Bourne at Chilworth. As this is October it could be muddy and you might want to bring your sticks. We will stop for a coffee break along the way to "recharge our batteries".
