



# TWERPS

*The West End Rambling for Pleasure Society*

**Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2009**

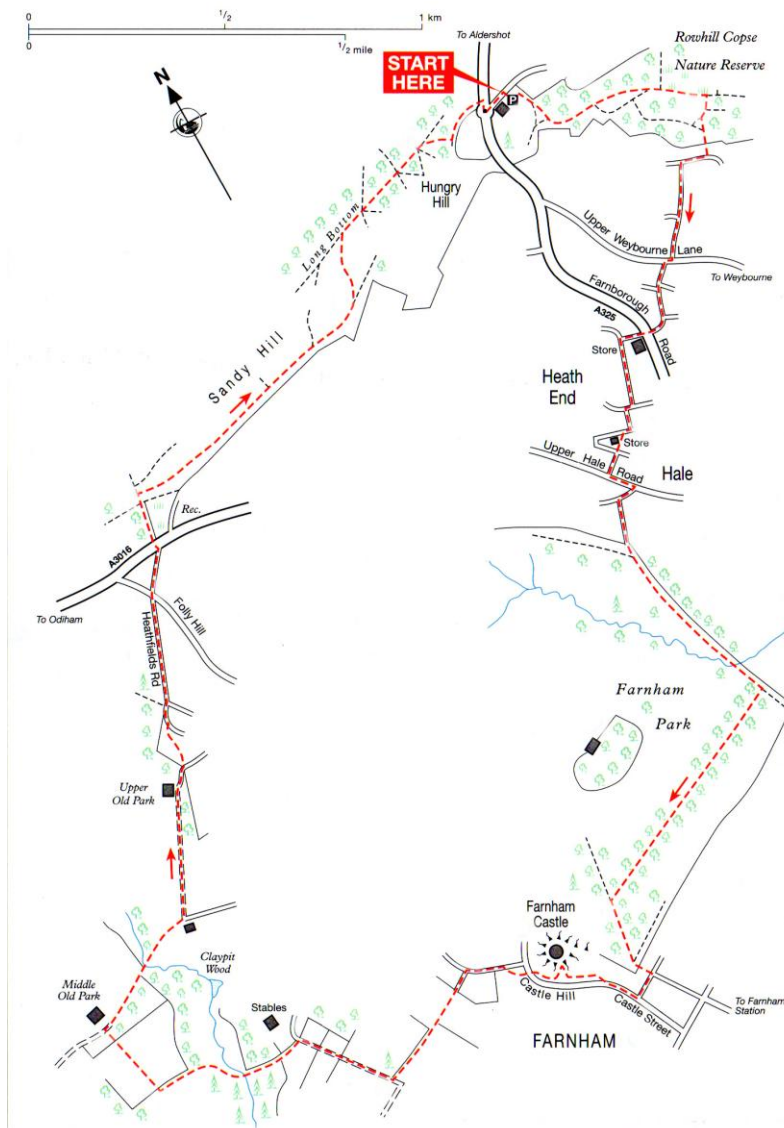
This new, 7 mile, walk is taken from a booklet describing walks in the Blackwater Valley. Although some of the walk is through residential areas, the later miles give stunning views

over the countryside on a clear day, even as far as London in one place, and **there are no stiles**. Note that there is no obvious short cut to the walk.

The terrain is mainly easy going but there are a couple of steepish, but short, climbs en route.

OS Explorer map 145 - grid ref. SU 849 499.

There are several ways to get to the starting point but the most straightforward way is to head south-west, on the A325, from Farnborough. At the end of a long straight you will reach Wellington Roundabout. Continue on the A325 for just over  $\frac{1}{2}$  a mile to a small roundabout just inside the 30 mph zone. Over to the left is the small Rowhill Nature Reserve car park in Cranmore Lane. Meeting time is 10 a.m. as usual and we will be stopping on the way for a short snack.
