

Dear WEAG Supporters

Welcome, first let me thank you on behalf of the recently formed WEAG Committee for your offer to support WEAG and in particular, those of you who have offered to help and work with us.

We all know why we have come together and some of us have been here before. Let me expand on this. WEAG has been re-formed to oppose inappropriate development and ensure that any future development of the village respects its identity and essential character and it is sustainable. We aim to define the nature and scale of development which the village needs; and to ensure that any such development is sustainable within the existing infrastructure.

Of note is that all of the proposed developments are on land formally classified as 'Countryside beyond the Green Belt'. The total number of almost 300 vastly exceeds the 20 new homes allocated in Surrey Heath BC's Core Strategy to West End for completion by 2025.

And now for some good news:

Results - Exit poll Taylor Wimpey Exhibition We interviewed 206 people, which is estimated to be more than 90% of all visitors leaving the exhibition by the Sports Pavilion main entrance. As you would expect a high number at 84% were opposed to the Taylor Wimpey proposals, 10% were in favour and the remaining 6% were unable to, or did not wish to say.

The inaugural meeting of the WEAG Committee was held on Tuesday 27th May. Here the vision and strategy of our campaign was discussed and officers were elected:
