89% oppose Malthouse Farm housing proposals

As you may know WEAG conducted an exit poll last week at the public exhibition of the Southern Heritage proposals for building 95 houses on the fields around Malthouse Farm.

The results show that 89% of West End residents who visited the exhibition opposed the development, and only 4% supported it. The remaining 7% didn't know. You can download the full report from our website <u>www.weag.info</u>.

This overwhelming opposition to the housing estate is similar to that at last year's public consultation by Taylor Wimpey to build 85 houses off Beldam Bridge Road. In the exit poll, 85% opposed the plans. We are confident that a similar result would have been obtained if an exit poll had been conducted at the earlier William Lacey public consultation for 84 houses south of Kings Road.

We are sending the exit poll report to the developer, our Parish, Borough and County Councillors, MP, local media, and others.
